Attached are the time lines and psych sheet for the 2012 Northeast IMXtreme Challenge meet. We have 577 swimmers entered into the meet representing 59 teams and 11 of our 12 LSC's in the Eastern Zone!!!

Please send this info to all participating families. Thank you all for supporting the meet and I hope you all have another great time at the meet and are able to get out and enjoy the DC area on Saturday afternoon / evening.

Couple of things to mention:

- 1) Please try to be at the pre-meet coaches meeting (Friday) and the post meet debriefing (Sunday).

- 3) We are not doing credentials for the athletes or coaches
- 4) WE WILL NEED TIMERS!! ;-) Please ask parents to help out. Parents will not be allowed on deck unless they are volunteering.
- 5) Kids need their own counter and timer for the 500 free on Friday
- 6) Meet is set up to run slow to fast for all events...don't ask, that's how USA-S wants it run
- 7) Last year we had very few scratches so I am thinking of just seeding the meet and running with it. If you know of any scratches a head of time (in the next 24 hours) please let me know BEFORE I seed the meet...THANKS!
- 8) Parking is limited at the venue...fits about 100 cars...there is on-street parking. The last big meet that was held at this facility, the neighbors decided to start charging for people to park on the street in front of their homes...A complaint was filed with the DC police but they kind of just shrugged their shoulders and said "Oh Well..." just be aware...if this starts to happen at this meet, you can tell your families to move their car somewhere else or pay the people if they want to...It's DC so they can take their own risk if they want to park and walk away.
(If you are driving to the meet, you may want to drive the family car that isn't the nice one.)
- 9) Don't leave any valuables in your car (especially if you park and walk away) ;-)
- 10) It's DC so please stay vigilant in and out of the facility...If your parents want to use laptops at the meet tell them to stay clear of the front row and aisles near the entrance doors.
- 11) A call has been made to the DC Police to have a patrol car(s) on site during the meet...not trying to scare anyone...just giving you all a heads up to be smart. It's really not that bad.
- 12) Admission and Programs are free...(Covered by swimmer surcharge).
